The #CaliforniansForAll College Corps Mid-Year Leadership Workshops (MYLWs) are one-day events where Fellows come together to learn, reflect and strengthen their leadership through interactive activities. For 2026, Fellows have the chance to design and lead peer-based sessions connected to this year's theme: **Growing Together as Leaders: Learning from Experience, Leading with Purpose.**

We invite you to submit a proposal to facilitate a 40-minute session. Sessions should be engaging, reflective, and connected to service-based leadership — whether through storytelling, skill-sharing, creative activity, or critical dialogue. Overview of Proposal Components

Your proposal should include the following key components:

- Title creative and clearly connected to the MYLW theme
- **Session Description** 150–200 words on focus, leadership/service connection and why it matters to fellows
- **Learning Outcomes** 2–3 clear takeaways for participants
- **Format & Track** session style (e.g., discussion, skill-building, storytelling, creative activity, etc.) and alignment with one of the four tracks:
 - 1. Purposeful Pathways values, identity, and long-term purpose
 - 2. Leadership in Action skills and mindsets for leadership
 - 3. Community & Connection collaboration and belonging
 - 4. Reflect & Reimagine lessons learned and visioning the future
- Connection to Theme how the session helps Fellows learn from experience and lead with purpose
- Agenda Outline a timed plan for a 40-minute session
- **Supplies/Tech Needs** what you'll need for your session. Note: technology (slides, projectors, AV) will not be available in workshop rooms, so sessions should be designed to work without tech.
- Presenter Info your name, campus, and short bio
- Support Person a peer, staff or faculty member to advise you in advance
