The City and County of San Francisco is the City's largest employer and offers opportunities for people from all programs and majors at SF State. Learn about the many departments and opportunities with the City and County of San Francisco. CCSF-DHR will be on hand for demonstration and guidance on how to apply for jobs using the new applicant tracking system, SmartRecruiters and will introduce the Access to City Employment (ACE) Program, including, program eligibility, the application and hiring process.

The ACE Program provides an alternative route toward permanent City employment for qualified disabled individuals. The ACE Program allows individuals who are eligible to enter the City workforce without going through the competitive civil service merit process, which would otherwise consist of successfully passing an examination and placement on an eligible list in a reachable rank. We encourage individuals with disabilities who are interested in the Access to City Employment (ACE) Program to participate in this virtual session.

This virtual session will provide you with everything you need to know about applying for government jobs with the City and County of San Francisco and becoming a civil servant.
