# BREAKDOWN OF PAYMENT TO FELLOWS: AY 2022-23

## DOMESTIC STUDENTS

### Status: U.S. Citizens & Permanent Residents

- ☐ Up to \$7000.00 Living Allowance paid monthly throughout term of service
- ☐ \$3000.00 Ed. Award upon completion of 450 hours
  - \$1,718.25: Segal Ed Award
  - \$1,281.75: CaliforniansForAll (CFA) Education Award

**Fellows can receive up to \$10,000.00 if all requirements are fulfilled**

## AB- 540 Students

### Education Award based on Eligibility : DSIG or CSU ED Award

#### Status: AB-540 Students that qualify Cal Grant B Education Award= DSIG

- ☐ Up to \$5,500 Living Allowance paid monthly throughout term of service
- ☐ \$4,500 Dreamers Service Incentive Grant (DSIG) from California Student Aid Commission upon completion of hrs.  
**\$10, 000**

#### Status: AB-540 Students that qualify Cal Grant A Education Award= CSU Ed Award

- ☐ Up to \$7,000 Living Allowance paid monthly throughout term of service
- ☐ \$3,000: CSU Ed. Award upon completion of 450 hours


## **Plan A: MAY 2023 service end date**

**(You are graduating May 2023 or continuing in Fall 2023)**

### **DOMESTIC STUDENTS**

**SERVICE END DATE: MAY 19, 2023\***

- ☐ Up to \$7000 Living Allowance paid monthly throughout term of service
- ☐ \$3000 Ed. Award upon completion of 450 hours
  - \$1,718.25 – Segal Ed Award
  - \$1,281.75\* – CFA Ed. Award (to get CFA Ed Award need to complete by May 19, 2023)



#### **\*BACKGROUND CONTEXT:**

- From August 2022 – May 2023, the U.S. Dept. of Education allowed a “waiver” for the *CaliforniansForAll* College Corps Program as it is a state disaster relief program related to the COVID-19 national emergency. What this means was that the College Corps program did not affect your AY 22-23 financial aid eligibility and package.
- This “waiver” expires in May 2023 and as a result, the end date of program is May 19, 2023 (last day of instruction). May 19th deadline because past this date will impact your AY 23-24 Financial Aid because now the living allowances and education awards – for all students – need to be coordinated by Financial Aid.

#### **\$7000 Living Allowance = Term of Service for 450 hours**

- May 2023 pay period will be paid out by June 15, 2023 - same as current process, paid directly to you as a monthly paycheck via direct deposit (if you signed up for this).
- Effective Feb. 2023 timesheet, students must have completed a minimum of 40 hours per monthly pay period or there will be a delay in payment

#### **\$3000 Ed. Award Upon completion of 450 hours**

##### ***Segal Education Award = \$1,718.25***

- Once you have successfully completed your 450 hours, you will request this yourself through your AmeriCorps profile at [my.americorps.gov](https://my.americorps.gov) Refer to slides 8-12. **You must complete the “exit form” in your MyAmeriCorps account for SF State College Corps to fully process.**

##### ***CaliforniaForAll (CFA) Education Award= \$1,281.75***

- This will be paid out to you directly as the same way as your living allowance by June 15, 2023

## Plan B: JULY 2023 service end date

(You are not graduating May 2023 and will enroll in Summer 2023 and/or Fall 2023)

### DOMESTIC STUDENTS

OPTIONAL SERVICE END DATE:  
JULY 31, 2023\*



#### \*BACKGROUND CONTEXT:

- From August 2022 – May 2023, the U.S. Dept. of Education allowed a “waiver” for the *CaliforniansForAll* College Corps Program as it is a state disaster relief program related to the COVID-19 national emergency. What this means was that the College Corps program did not affect your financial aid eligibility and package.
- This “waiver” expires in May 2023 and as a result if you choose the July 31, 2023 extension option, this may have an impact on your AY 23-24 financial aid package because now the living allowances and education awards – for all students – need to be coordinated by Financial Aid.

#### **\$7000 Living Allowance = Term of Service for 450 hours**

- July 2023 extension: adjustment to monthly amount payments will be made to reflect additional two months of service.
- Effective Feb. 2023 timesheet, students must have completed a minimum of 40 hours per monthly pay period or there will be a delay in payment
- Pay mechanism: June and July 2023 payments will be paid out the same as current process, paid directly to you as a monthly paycheck via direct deposit (If you signed up for this)

#### **\$3000 Ed. Award Upon Completion of 450 hours**

- Once you have successfully completed your 450 hours, you will request this yourself through your AmeriCorps profile at [my.americorps.gov](https://my.americorps.gov) Refer to slides 8-12. You must complete the “exit form” in your MyAmeriCorps account for SF State College Corps to fully process.

##### ***CaliforniansForAll (CFA) Education Award=\$1,281.75***

- Once you have successfully completed your 450 hours, your CFA Ed. Award will be allocated through the same process as your monthly allowance payment.

# **DOMESTIC GRADUATING STUDENTS:**

## **WHO WISH TO HAVE JULY 2023 service end date**

(You are graduating May 2023 and will not enroll in fall 2023)

### **DOMESTIC STUDENTS**

**OPTION SERVICE END DATE:  
JULY 31, 2023\***

**NOTE:**

- If you are graduating in May 2023 and want the option to work until July 31, 2023, your CFA Education Award payout will be allocated through a non-CSU stipend.\*

*\*non-CSU stipend means a pay mechanism to pay non-CSU students.*



### **\$7000 Living Allowance = Term of Service**

- July 2023 extension: adjustment to monthly amount payments will be made to reflect additional two months of service.
- Effective Feb. 2023 timesheet, students must have completed a minimum of 40 hours per monthly pay period or there will be a delay in payment
- June-July 2023 monthly living allowance will go directly to you via physical check (a non-CSU stipend). \*non-CSU stipend means a pay mechanism to pay non-CSU students.

### **\$3000 Ed. Award Upon completion of 450 hours**

#### ***Segal Ed. Award = \$1718.25***

- Once you have successfully completed your 450 hours, you will request this yourself through your AmeriCorps profile at [my.americorps.gov](https://my.americorps.gov) Refer to slides 8-12. You must complete the "exit form" in your MyAmeriCorps account for SF State College Corps to fully process.

#### ***CaliforniansForAll (CFA Education Award) = \$1,281.75***

- If you complete 450 hours by July 31, 2023, you will receive your CFA Award directly to you via physical check (a non-CSU stipend).

# How to access the Segal Education Award

# DOMESTIC STUDENTS:

## AmeriCorps Segal Ed. Award Distribution Process

### STEP A

- ICCE/College Corps staff will unlock the AmeriCorps “exit form” in your MyAmericaCorps account.
- Fellows will automatically receive an email asking them to complete their part of the “exit form”.

### STEP B

- Fellows then log into their MyAmeriCorps portal and must complete their portion of the “exit form”
- *NOTE: Your Education Award cannot be processed until you complete this “exit form”.*

### STEP C

- Once Fellows complete their “exit form”, ICCE/College Corps staff can then will complete their part to complete the exit process for Fellows to be eligible for the Segal Award.

### STEP D


- Fellows via MyAmeriCorps authorize how they like receive/use Segal Award.

As outlined in your original Fellow Service Agreement, only Fellows who complete at least 450 service hours are eligible to receive the \$3,000 Education Award (a Segal Education Award and a state supplemental education award.)
